# BI-STATE SAGE-GROUSE WORKDAYS

Join Eastern Sierra Land Trust and the Bureau of Land Management as we team up to improve Bi-State sage-grouse habitat. On August 22nd and 23rd from 9am-12pm, we will be removing conifer seedlings that are invading sagebrush habitat near Bridgeport. These trees provide perches for predators that prey on sage-grouse eggs and chicks.

Coffee and pastries will be provided. Bring a hat, closed-toe shoes, sunscreen, a camera, and water; please leave pets at home.
